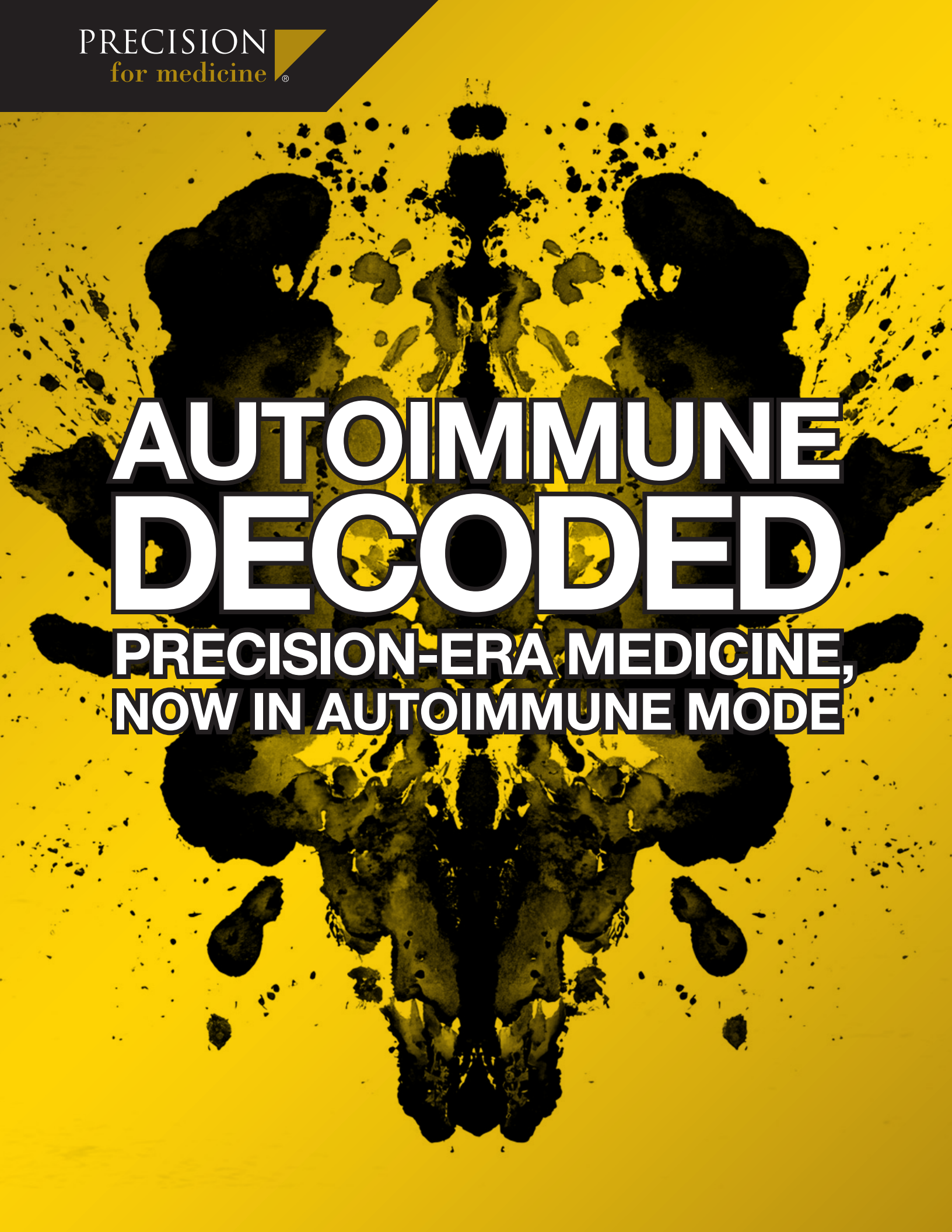

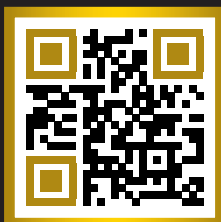

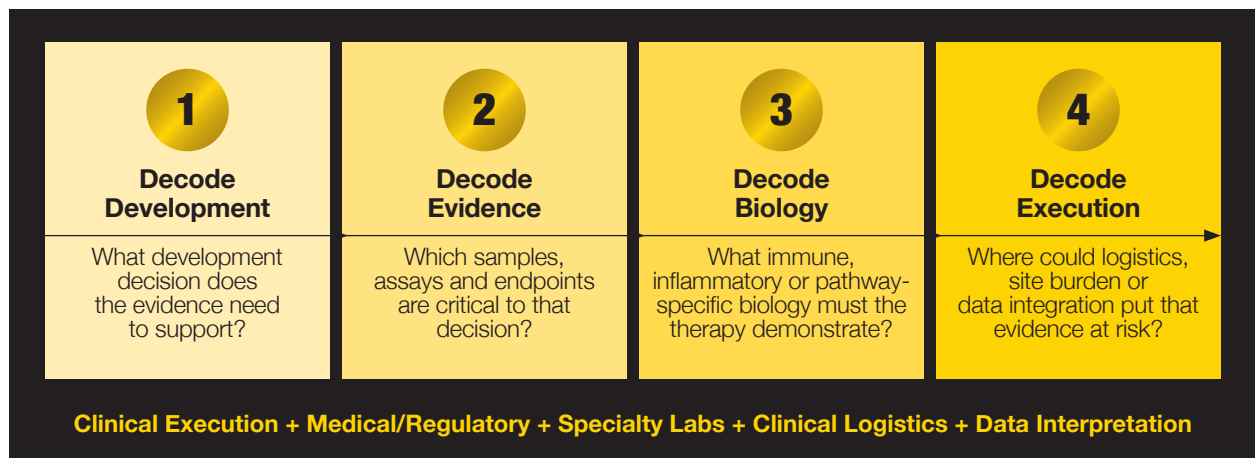

Complex Autoimmune Therapy Execution with Translational Science Built-In

Execution decisions can shape what the science ultimately reveals. Protocol design, site readiness, patient burden, safety oversight and trial delivery all have a bearing on the evidence you can generate.

Precision has designed a system that brings clinical operations together with translational science, rheumatology leadership, and IVD/CDx regulatory expertise. It connects clinical delivery, assay planning, sample logistics and evidence integration before critical choices harden.

Read and Decode the Immune System. Don't Just Run a Panel

There is no universal autoimmune assay panel. The assay mix changes with modality, construct, sample type, validation status and the biology the program needs to understand. Precision has a specialty-lab stack to match sponsors' development questions.

CAR-T. The Questions Get Even More Specific

In autoimmune CAR-T, clinical execution and translational science need to move together with safety the key consideration.

Depletion is only part of the picture. Depending on the program, the questions that follow may include reconstitution, therapy persistence, safety, and extent and duration of clinical response.

No fixed approach. No one-size-fits-all panel. The biology determines the evidence strategy.

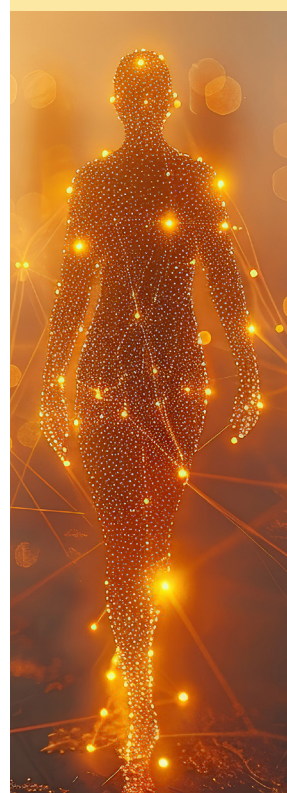

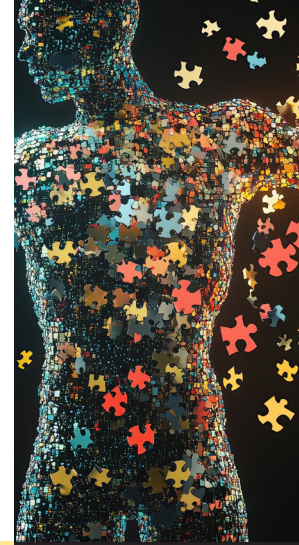

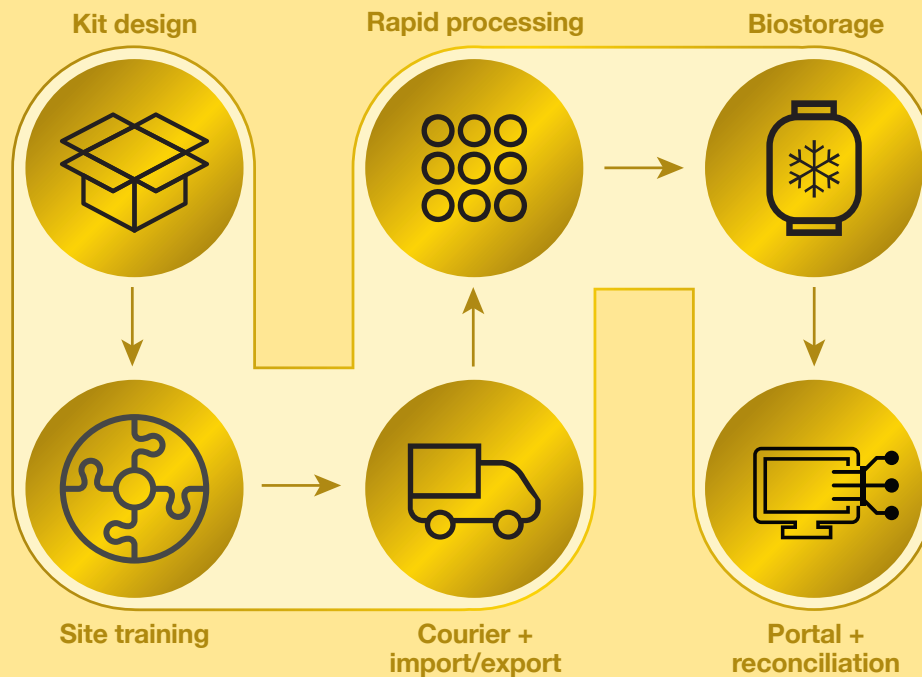


You Can't Decipher What You Didn't Collect
